- ▶ GPS

Is it secure?

Adobe Acrobat™ PDF document, whilst researching your competitors on the internet, then a more suitable mobile device would be a PDA or XDA type device.

If you have an existing laptop or tablet PC it is possible to connect remotely using 3G or GPRS mobile phone technology via a data card solution that provides access to all of the business tools you use at your desk whilst working on the move.



What do I need to make this work?

You must have the Premium Edition of Windows Small Business Server 2003 or Windows Small Business Server 2003 R2. There is an upgrade available if you currently have the Standard Edition.



Your mobile devices should have Windows Mobile 5.0 installed and any Laptop or Tablet PC you wish to use should have either Windows 2000 Professional or Windows XP Professional / Tablet Edition installed.

How much does it cost?

There are a number of different voice and data plans available from the mobile phone companies. You need to ascertain the level of functionality and the amount of data that you are likely to need to access on a monthly basis. This will determine exactly how much it will cost. But mobility solutions start from as little as £20.00 per month.
